
Privacy Policy

Thanks for visiting superbid.io. Your privacy is important to us. This Privacy Policy describes the types of information that Escape Velocity Sp. z o.o. may collect from you or which you may provide when visiting superbid.io and the products, functions, materials, and services we offer. This Policy also describes our policies and procedures of collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing this information.

This Policy applies to information we collect on the website and when you use the Services in general (including when registering an account) and through communications between you and the Site (including emails, texts, and other electronic messages).

Please read this Policy carefully. By accessing or using the Services (or by clicking "accept" or "agree to" this Policy when asked to do so), you are agreeing to the terms of this Policy on behalf of yourself or the entity you represent. If you do not agree to any of the terms of this Policy, you should refrain from continuing to use our Services.

Please be advised that the Website may contain links enabling its Users to directly reach other websites. Escape Velocity Sp. z o.o. has no influence on the privacy policy of their administrators and the use of cookies. We recommend that before using the resources offered by other websites, each User read the document regarding the privacy policy and the use of cookies if they have been made available, and if they are not available, contact the editors of the website to obtain information on this subject.

§ 1. Responsible body/the Administrator

§ 2. Terms of collecting personal data

1. While browsing the content of the Website, we may collect device and browser metadata, such as IP addresses, operating system type and version, date and time of access, URLs of visited pages and the time you visited these pages, any referring page URLs, interactions with the interface, user, access provider name and analytical information used by Google Firebase, Google Analytics, Facebook, AppsFlyer, Amplitude, items users like, and possibly others. To the extent that we collect this data, we may use it for the following purposes:

- ensuring a smooth connection with the Services;
 - analytical and statistical purposes;
 - getting to know the level of Users' satisfaction and identifying areas for improvement;
 - assessing the security and stability of the system, and
 - for general administrative purposes.
2. The legal basis for the processing of the data described above is the legitimate interest of the Administrator (Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR).
 3. Just browsing the Website does not require the user to provide his personal data.
 4. The use of some of the Website's functionalities may be preceded by a registration process, which may involve the provision of personal data by the User. In this case, failure to provide personal data by the User may limit the use of certain functionalities of the Website.

§ 3. Scope, purpose, and legal basis for the processing of personal data

1. Users' personal data are collected in the case of:
 - a. account registration on the Website - in order to create an individual account, manage this account and enable the User to access specific functions, products and services that are at the disposal of registered users. The legal basis for processing is the necessity of processing to perform the contract for the provision of the Account service (Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR);
 - b. concluding a sales or service contract - in order to perform the concluded contract. The legal basis for processing is the necessity of processing to perform a contract, the subject of which is the purchase of a product or service (Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR);
 - c. subscription to the newsletter (Newsletter) - in order to perform the contract, the subject of which is the service provided electronically, i.e. sending information about currently available products and services, competitions, promotional campaigns, and events. The legal basis for processing is the consent of the data subject (Article 6 (1) (a) of the GDPR);
 - d. using the contact form service on the Website - in order to perform the contract provided electronically, i.e. to answer the query submitted by the Website User. The legal basis for processing is the necessity of processing to perform the contract for the provision of the contact form service (Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR).
2. Personal data is also processed:
 - a. in order to fulfill the statutory obligations incumbent on the Administrator, resulting in particular from tax and accounting regulations - the legal basis for processing is the legal obligation (Article 6 (1) (c) of the GDPR);

- b. in order to possibly establish and pursue claims or defend against them - the legal basis for processing is the legitimate interest of the Administrator (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR) consisting in the protection of its rights.
3. When registering an account on the Website, the User provides:
 - a. First name and last name;
 - b. E-mail address;
 - c. Account username;
 - d. Phone number;
 - e. cryptocurrency wallet address.
4. In the case of Entrepreneurs/Companies, the above scope of data is additionally extended by:
 - a. Entrepreneur/Company's company;
 - b. NIP number/Tax Registration number
5. When registering an account on the Website, the User independently sets an individual password to access his account.
6. The condition for using the services available on the Website, with the exception of the newsletter service and the contact form service, is registration and setting up a user account. Personal data collected during the registration process are therefore used to enable the User to log in to the Website and use the functionalities, access to which is preceded by the registration process.
7. In the case of using the contact form service, the User provides the following data:
 - a. First name and last name
 - b. E-mail address;
 - c. Phone number
8. The personal data provided by the User in the contact form are used to answer the query submitted by the Website User.
9. Personal data provided when subscribing to the Newsletter in the form of an e-mail address are used to send messages to the User containing information about currently available services, products, competitions, and promotional campaigns.
10. The provision of the personal data described above is voluntary, but the consequence of not providing them is the User's inability to use the services available on the website.

§ 4. Recipients of personal data provided

The User's personal data is provided to service providers used by the Administrator to run the Website. These entities may be processors or independent administrators of your personal data. These entities are, for example: hosting companies, companies that support online payments, companies that provide statistical tools and applications (eg Google Analytics). We may also disclose your personal data to entities authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law, when they make such a request based on an appropriate legal basis.

§ 5. The period of personal data processing

1. The period of data processing by the Administrator depends on the type of service provided and the purpose of processing. As a rule, data is processed for the duration of the service or the performance of the order, until the consent is withdrawn or an effective objection to data processing is raised in cases where the legal basis for data processing is the Administrator's legitimate interest.
2. The data processing period may be extended if the processing is necessary to establish and assert any claims or defend against them, and after that time only if and to the extent that it will be required by law. After the expiry of the processing period, the data is irreversibly deleted or anonymized.

§ 6. Rights of users/Users permissions

Users have the following rights:

1. the right to access your personal data;
2. the right to request rectification of personal data;
3. the right to delete personal data;
4. the right to limit personal data;
5. the right to object to the processing;
6. the right to transfer personal data;
7. the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data processed on the basis of the consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of the processing which was carried out on the basis of the consent given before its withdrawal.
8. the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

§ 7. Personal data protection

1. The personal data administrator makes every effort to ensure the protection of information provided by users and personal data provided when using the Website, in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and the EU Council 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and in the matter the free movement of such data (GDPR). We have implemented technical, physical, and administrative security measures to reduce the risk

of loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, or modification of your information. We have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and management procedures to protect the information we collect. All information you give us is stored on our secure servers behind firewalls. When you transmit highly sensitive information (such as a credit card number) through the Services, we encrypt the transmission of that information using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology.

2. The security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password to access certain parts of the Services, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. Please do not share your password with anyone.
3. Although we have implemented security technologies and procedures to help protect your personal information, no system or network can guarantee 100% security. Unauthorized entry or use, hardware or software failure, and other factors may compromise the security of your information at any time. Any transmission of personal data is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on the Site or other Services.

§ 8. Cookies

On the Website, we use cookies, i.e. small files that the website or its service provider sends to the computer's hard drive via a web browser (if you give your consent). These cookies allow the website to recognize your browser and, if you have a registered account, associate it with the registered account. We use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits, and to compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better experiences and tools in the future. We may enter into agreements with third-party service providers to help us better understand our website visitors. These service providers may not use information collected on our behalf except to help us run and improve our business

§ 9. Child Protection Privacy Policy

The Services and their content are not intended for or directed at children under the age of thirteen (13). No one under the age of thirteen (13) may transfer any personal information to or through the Services. Please note that we do not knowingly collect any personal information from children under the age of thirteen (13).
